

## CalFresh Increases by County in California from 2006 - 2011

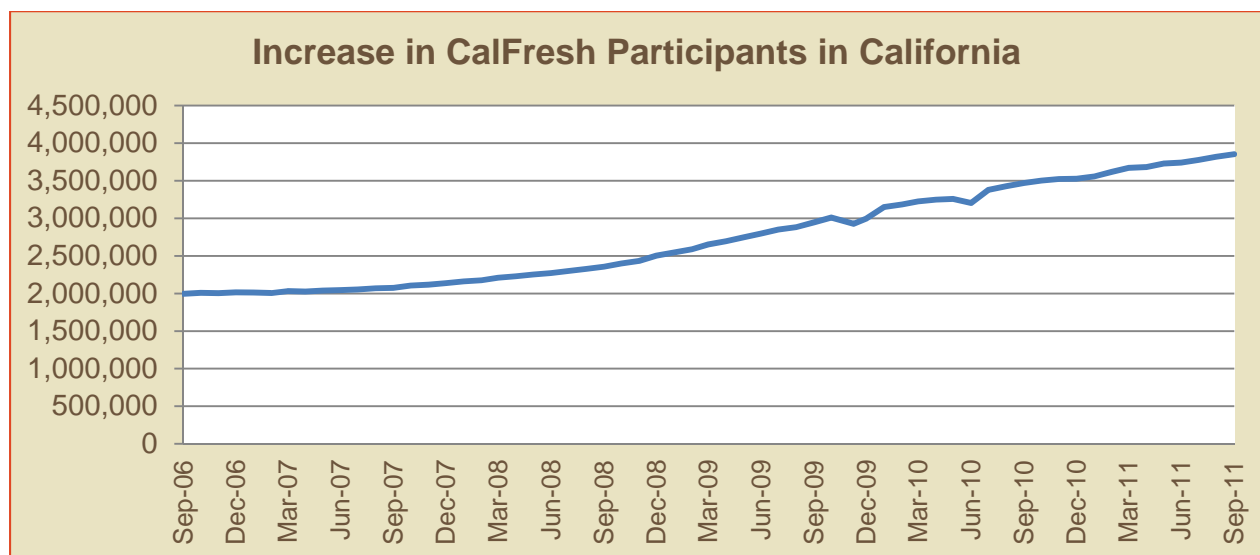
