



Five Quick Ways to Redesign your Cafeteria for Less Than \$10

1. Put fruits in **bright plastic bowls**. Plastic bowls make cleaning easy and the bright colors make fruits stand out more.
2. Use **white erase board** to advertise your menu. It's a perfect alternative for window service. It will brighten up windows and allow students to learn about their menu options. Make sure to use **creative names** to describe what's for lunch.
3. Use **vinyl tablecloths**. You can dress up a serving cart for fruits, utensils or condiments by using bright and fun tablecloths. Vinyl tablecloths are durable and easy to clean.

5. Use **plastic sign holders** on baskets, racks, trays or on the serving line to advertise today's specials, put up pictures, promote a new menu item...etc. Make sure to write your message on both sides before placing it on the holder.
